REGISTRATION AND PROGRAM ORGANIZATION

3 WEEK MODULE

› **DATES** : Monday, June 29th to Friday, July 17th, 2020
(arrive Sunday, June 28th and depart Saturday, July 18th)

› **PROGRAM FEE** : 2 000 €

› **INCLUDED** : all class sessions, visits and activities, lodging, transportation, breakfasts and evening meals, course grades.

› **NOT INCLUDED** :

› France-Raleigh plane ticket fare*

› lunches, health insurance and spending money

› **REGISTRATION DATES**: Tuesday, December 11th, 2019 to Tuesday, April 28th, 2020 (must pay 25% of program fees upon registration)

› **FINAL PAYMENT DEADLINE**: Monday, June 1st, 2020 (one month prior to program start date)

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

In order to travel you must be (at least) 18 years old and have these required documents :

- › Valid passport
- › ESTA
- › Visa (if needed)

Registered students will receive a detailed practical information guide in March. You may consult the US Ambassador website in the interim for more travel information.

ON SITE

› **Lodging**: two students per room at an on campus residence at North Carolina State University

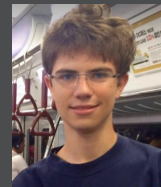

› **Transportation**: for the most part, it will be via public transportation or the on campus bus line, the Wolfline. There will be private transportation companies hired for the weekend trips.

› **Meals**: Breakfast and evening meals are included at the university dining hall during the week and in local restaurants during the weekends.

For lunches, there are several restaurants in close proximity to SKEMA US campus and in the weekend visit locations.

› **Chaperones**: There will be an APHEC representative/professor, as well as a SKEMA US representative, accompanying the students throughout the entire program.
